

Animal Control Continuing Education Credits

Several states have offered continuing education credits to Animal Control Officers for attending specific sessions relevant to their field. Proper paperwork will be required in order to receive any and all credit for attending each session; this paperwork will be available for pick up during “check in” at the conference. See below for the approved sessions per state to find out how many CE credits are available to you.

Massachusetts: 1.5 CE credits for any session attended on either Sunday or Monday of the conference

Connecticut: 1.5 CE credits for each session that falls under Track A on Monday April 9th

Maine: 1.5 CE credits for any session attended on either Sunday or Monday of the conference

New Hampshire: No CE credits required by state

Vermont: No CE credits required by state

Rhode Island: TDB

Each Animal Control Officer will be responsible for filling the appropriate paperwork with their own state to receive proper credit
